WHO IS GOD?

Before we ask what God says about animals...
we have to ask something deeper.

Who is God?

GOD IS LOVE.

1 John 4:8

Not just as an idea...
but as the source of life itself.

Everything that exists—
humans, animals, the earth—
came from that same source.

The same breath.
The same worth.
The same origin.
The same Creator.



We Are
ALL
God's Creation

God did not create life in fragments.
He did not divide His presence.
He did not assign value based on form.

Scripture reveals something most of us were never taught to fully
see:

Christ is All and in All.

Col 3:11

Not some.
Not only humanity.
All.

If that is true...
then nothing alive is empty of Him.
And if nothing alive is empty of Him...
then nothing alive is without value.

THE FIRST RELATIONSHIP

In the beginning...
before fear
before survival
before disconnection
before violence
there was peace.

Animals were not introduced as resources.

They were brought to man.

Not as property.

Not as provision.

But as our Neighbors.

They were named.

They were known.

They were loved.

They lived together.

Side by side.

Without fear.

Without violence.

Without hierarchy of worth.

This was the original design.

And even now... we still remember it.

- We name animals.
- We care for them.
- We feel connected to them.
- We grieve them.
- We love them.

Because something in us recognizes something in them.

Their innocence, purity & their reflection of God.

DOMINION

Dominion was given.
But how it is expressed matters.

It can reflect care...
or it can reflect control.

The word itself does not define which.
The heart of God does.

If dominion reflects God... it truly reflects:

- care
- responsibility
- protection
- stewardship

Not harm.

So when harm is present... we have to ask:
Are we reflecting His Love... or using His words to justify something
else?

THE BREAK

Something shifted.
But it wasn't God.

Disconnection entered.

What was once good and relational...
became distant.

What was once near, became far.
And once something becomes other...
the unthinkable
becomes justifiable.

WHAT DISCONNECTION CREATED

Over time... this disconnection formed systems.
Systems that:

- decided worth and took control
- normalized harm and cruelty

Not because people don't care.
But because they felt powerless.

But even in this...
something true remains.

RESTORATION

Nothing created in alignment with God is ever truly lost.

It can be covered.

Distorted.

Forgotten.

But not removed.

Restoration begins when awareness returns.

When something inside of us...
recognizes what has always been true.

CHRIST IN ALL CREATION

Christ is All and in All.

Life itself carries His presence.

Not in identical expression...

but in shared source.

He is not separate from creation.

He is the source, the substance, and the life within all things.

In Him all things hold together.

Col 1:16–17

Christ is within you — not outside of you.

Not something to reach for,

but something to awaken to.

Our identity.

And this is why disconnection feels wrong.

Because something in us knows:

we were never separate from what we are harming.

CREATION IS WAITING

All of creation is waiting...

for the Sons & Daughters of God to be revealed.

Creation is not suffering randomly.

It remembers something whole.

And it is waiting for that wholeness to return — through us.

Romans 8:19–21



And that is who we are.
For those who remember who they are.

For those who begin to reflect:

love
truth
compassion

THE HORSES

Horses carry something sacred —
people sense it even when they can't explain it.

God's Presence.

They haven't divided themselves from it the way we have.

They still live within it —
responding to love, truth and integrity,
discerning what is real and what is not.

And because they remain whole...
they become a mirror.

When you are present with a horse,
something in you remembers what you forgot.

They are not waiting for humanity to teach them.

They are waiting for humanity to return.

Horses are not just part of creation —
they are part of what is waiting.

Waiting for sons and daughters to come back
to who they were always created to be.

Horses have not disconnected the way we have.

We force them through worldly systems
that do not reflect that reality.

Horses are:

- exploited
- abused
- sold
- transported
- passed through hands
- and often end up in places no one would want to see

Not because they lost value...
but because the system does not recognize them
for who they truly are.

Most people looking at this...
feel something.

A pull.

A discomfort.

A knowing.

Not because someone explained it...
but because something in their heart recognizes it.

AND STILL THE SLAUGHTER PIPELINE CONTINUES

Not because people don't care.
But because the way we've been taught to help...

keeps feeding the same system.

Money moves.

Horses move.

The pipeline stays open.

Because stepping in feels like rescue.

And in the moment... it is.

But zoom out...

and the same cycle repeats.

Again.

And again.

And again.

This is not failure.

This is not lack of compassion.

This is a system that was never designed to end itself.

And once you see that...

something shifts.

Not guilt.

Not pressure.

Clarity.

THE SHIFT

A different question begins to form.

Not:

How do I save this one right now?

But:

Why are they ending up here at all?

And even deeper:

What would it look like to stop this before it starts?

Because that is where real change lives.

Not inside the cycle...

But outside of it.

THE INVITATION

Now that you see...

you can't go back to not seeing.

Not everything.

Not all at once.

But something has shifted.

What does it look like to live in alignment with this?

Not perfectly.

But honestly.

Because this is not about doing more.

It's about seeing differently.

And when you see differently...

you begin to choose differently.

You are not being asked to carry this alone.

You are not responsible for fixing everything.

But you are being invited...

to respond to what you now recognize.

To pause. To question. To choose differently.

To ask:

Is this helping... or continuing the cycle?

We are building something that:

- protects before crisis
- restores connection
- keeps horses out of the pipeline

To become part of something new.

Not reacting to what is broken...

But helping build what was always needed.

A NEW WAY

A new way is being built.

Not inside the system...

But beyond it.

- protects horses before they reach crisis
 - supports people
- removes the need for the cycle

Not by reacting...

But by preventing.

Colossians 1:27

Christ in you, the hope of glory.

Colossians 2:9–10

In Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, and in Christ you have been brought to fullness.

Ephesians 1:10

To bring unity to all things in heaven and on earth under Christ.

Ephesians 1:22–23

The fullness of Him who fills everything in every way.

Ephesians 4:6

One God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

Romans 8:19–21
